This letter comes to you with its attached Appeal Memorandum for the explicate reason of requesting Your committee direct the Supreme Court Conduct Study Committee to make the (5) 28 U.S.C. 351 Complaints reach "Public Visibility" doing so in order to overcome the fraudulent concealment of the 28 U.S.C. 351 Complaints.
